COURSES

Students enroll in four courses offered by other UBU schools in the areas of humanities. business administration, economics, education and communication, and political

With advanced approval of the director and a Boston University Charles River Campus professor, students may enroll in a directed study for four academic credits. (Boston University Students Only)

Burgos University Spanish Studies Program

Boston University's program in Burgos, situated two hours north of Madrid, offers students a semester of study in one of Spain's most vibrant and culturally rich cities. The program is located at the University of Burgos (UBU), a university situated amidst a medieval complex of buildings that was once part of the Camino de Santiago.

Upon successful completion of a semester, students earn 16 Boston University credits.

HOST INSTITUTION

With an 11,000-strong student population, the University of Burgos is quickly building a national and international reputation as one of Spain's leading universities. UBU is equipped with modern facilities such as libraries, computer labs, and sport facilities, and it organizes numerous extra-curricular activities, including a theatre group and a choir, and hiking fieldtrips in which BU students may participate. UBU also has agreements with cultural institutions in the city such as the Main Theater and local museums.

HOUSING

Students have the option of sharing a double room with a Spanish student in UBU residence halls or living with a local host family. The dorms are equipped with dining halls in which students can take all their meals. Students who live with host families will take meals with their families.

EXCURSIONS

Excursions include several cultural visits to sites in central and northern Spain, and southern Spain where students travel to Seville, Madrid, La Rioja, Camino de Santiago and others.
