

Financial Aid Consortium Agreement
for
**Enrollment when Host Institution is Another
Domestic U. S. University**

This financial aid consortium agreement is required by the federal government for either postsecondary institution listed below to pay or process Federal (Pell Grant, Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, Federal Direct Loan, PLUS Loan) or state award for a student who is enrolled as a non-degree student at the **Host Institution** but is a matriculated undergraduate degree candidate at **Boston University**.

Instructions

Section I: must be completed by the student. Further, the student is responsible for ensuring that the remaining sections are completed as specified. **All** required items (front and back) must be completed **before** Boston University Financial Assistance can process any federal or state financial aid for which you may, as a student matriculated into a degree program at Boston University taking classes at another institution (the Host Institution), be eligible. Student loan borrowers are responsible for making any necessary arrangements with their lenders to ensure that their student loans do not go into repayment status while they are enrolled at the Host Institution.

Section II: must be completed by an official of the Financial Aid Office at the Host Institution.

Section III: must be completed by the student's Boston University school or college's Office of the Academic Dean at Boston University for students enrolling at another domestic U. S. University during a fall, spring or summer semester, and must confirm that credits earned at the Host Institution will be accepted toward the completion of your degree.
