Abortion	X			Expenses paid for a legal abortion are eligible for reimbursement.
Acupuncture	X			Expenses paid for acupuncture treatments are eligible for reimbursement.
Allergy Medicines	X			<p>Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter allergy medicines are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.</p> <p>Some examples include:</p> <p>Allegra, Benadryl, Claritin, Dimetapp, Generics, Zyrtec, ect.</p>
Ambulance	X			Expenses paid for ambulance services are eligible for reimbursement.
Antacids	X			<p>Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter antacids are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.</p> <p>Some examples include:</p> <p>Alka Seltzer, Generics, Maalox, Pepto-Bismol, Prilosec, Tums ect.</p>
Antibiotic ointment	X			Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter antibiotic ointments are eligible for

reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.

Some examples include:

Aspirin	X			Expenses paid for over the counter aspirin are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.

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Bandages	X			Expenses paid for bandages/medical supplies used to cover torn skin are eligible for reimbursement. Some examples include: Ace bandages, Band Aid, Generic bandages, Nexcare, ect.
Blood sugar test kits and strips	X			Expenses paid for blood sugar monitoring devices and testing strips are eligible for reimbursement.

C

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Car	X			The expenses of special hand controls and other special equipment installed in a car for the use of a person with a disability are eligible for reimbursement.
Chiropractor	X			Expenses paid to chiropractors for medical services are eligible for reimbursement

Coinsurance	X	Expenses paid towards coinsurance amounts are eligible for reimbursement. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed from other sources.
Cold medicine	X	<p>Medical expenses paid for over the counter cold medicines are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.</p> <p>Some examples include:</p> <p>Alka-Seltzer, Dayquil/ Nyquil, Pediapcare, Generic cold medicines, Robitussin, Sudafed, Theraflu, Triaminic, Tylenol, Zicam, ect</p>
Cold/hot packs	X	Expenses paid for over the counter cold/hot packs when used for treatment of injuries are eligible for reimbursement.
Concierge medicine	X	<p>Eligible expenses for concierge medicine are limited to the expense of medical care (physical exams), you may not include the expenses that are not directly related to medical care such as preferred appointment fees, on call fees, ect.</p> <p>When submitting a claim, supporting documentation must be broken down to individual components that show the expense of medical care.</p>
Contact Lenses & Contact Lens Solution	X	Expenses paid for vision correcting contact lenses are eligible for reimbursement. Expenses for contact lens

			supplies are also considered an eligible expense.	
Copayments	X		Copays for medical services are eligible for reimbursement. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed from other sources.	
Cosmetic procedures		X	Eligible expenses for cosmetic procedures are limited to surgery or services necessary to improve a deformity arising from, or directly related to, a congenital abnormality, a personal injury resulting from an accident or trauma, or a disfiguring disease.	
Cosmetic procedures			X	Cosmetic procedures to improve/enhance general appearance are not eligible for reimbursement.
Cough/throat drops	X			Expenses paid for over the counter cough/throat drops and sprays are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor. Some examples include: Chloraseptic, Generic cough/throat drops/spray, Halls, Ricola, ect
Crutches	X			Expenses paid for purchase or rental of crutches are eligible for reimbursement.
Controlled Substances			X	Expenses paid for controlled substances which violate federal law, even if prescribed and do not violate state law, are not eligible for reimbursement.
Cobra premiums			X	Insurance premiums are not eligible for reimbursement.

D

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Dental Treatment	X			<p>Expenses paid for dental treatments are eligible for reimbursement.</p> <p>Some examples include:</p> <p>Bridges, Cleanings, Crowns, Dentures, Extractions, Fillings, Root canals, Orthodontia, X-rays, ect</p> <p>Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed form other sources.</p>
Deductibles	X			<p>Payments made towards an annual deductible for health care are eligible for reimbursement. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed form other sources.</p>
Decongestants	X			<p>Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter decongestants are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.</p> <p>Some examples include:</p> <p>Afrin, Generic decongestants, Mucinex, Sudafed, Vicks, ect</p>
Dermatology	X			<p>Expenses paid to dermatologists for non-cosmetic medical services are eligible for reimbursement. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed form</p>

other sources.

Diabetic equipment, supplies	X			Medical expenses paid for diagnosing and treating of diabetes are eligible for reimbursement.
Drugs	X			Medical expenses paid for drugs, prescription and OTC with a prescription from your doctor, that are used to treat illness or injuries are eligible for reimbursement.
Durable medical equipment (DME)		X		When deemed medically necessary for treatment of a specific medical condition the expenses of durable medical equipment are eligible for reimbursement.

Ear drops/wax removal	X			Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter ear drops/wax removal medicines are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.

Eye drops	X			Expenses paid for

prescription and over the counter eye drops* are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.

Funeral expenses			X	Funeral expenses are not eligible for reimbursement.

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Health Maintenance Organization (HMO)			X	Insurance premiums are not eligible for reimbursement.
Hearing Aids	X			Expenses paid for hearing aids and required batteries are eligible for reimbursement.
Hemorrhoid treatment	X			Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter hemorrhoid medicines/ointments are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor. Some examples include: Anusol, Generics, Preparation H, Tucks, ect

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Insurance premiums			X	Insurance premiums are not eligible for reimbursement.
Immunizations	X			Expenses paid for immunizations are eligible for reimbursement.
Insect bite cream and ointment	X			Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter insect bite cream and ointment with a prescription from your doctor are eligible for reimbursement. Some examples include: After bite, Calamine lotion, Cortizone, Generics, Mitigator, ect
Insulin	X			Expenses paid for insulin are eligible for reimbursement.

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Laboratory Fees	X			Expenses paid for laboratory fees for medical care are eligible for reimbursement. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed from other sources.
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Lodging	X			Expenses paid for lodging and meals while at a hospital or similar institution for medical care are eligible for reimbursement.

LASIK and laser eye surgery	X			Expenses paid for LASIK and laser eye vision correction surgery are eligible for reimbursement.

Late fees payments			X	Late payment fees are not eligible for reimbursement.
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Laxatives	X			Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter laxatives are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor. Some examples include: Colace, Correctol, Ex-Lax, Generics,

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Medicines	X			Expenses paid for medicines, prescription and OTC with a prescription from your doctor, that are used to treat illness or injuries are eligible for reimbursement.
Medicines (Imported)			X	Drugs and medicines imported from foreign countries are not eligible for reimbursement.
Medicines (Purchase and use while abroad)	X			Expenses paid for medicines, while abroad, that are used to treat illness or injuries are eligible for reimbursement. The medicine must be legal in both the country you are traveling in and the United States. When submitting supporting documentation please have all items translated and currencies converted.
Medical monitoring and testing devices	X			Expenses paid for medical monitoring and testing devices for use of diagnosing and treating illness and disease are eligible for reimbursement.
Medical records	X			
Missed appointment fee			X	Expenses due to a missed appointment are not eligible for reimbursement.

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Nursing Home	X			Expenses paid for the cost of medical care provided in a nursing home, home for the aged, or similar institution for yourself, spouse, or

dependants eligible for reimbursement. Lodging and meal expenses incurred in the home are also eligible for reimbursement if a principle reason for being in the home is to get medical care.

Neurologist

Expenses paid to neurologists for medical care are eligible for reimbursement. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed from other sources.

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Optometrist	X			Expenses paid to an optometrist for vision correcting services are eligible for reimbursement. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed from other sources.
Osteopath	X			Expenses paid to an osteopath are eligible for reimbursement

Over the counter medicines	X			<p>Medical expenses paid for over the counter items that are used to alleviate symptoms of illness or injury are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor. (Please note items such as minerals, vitamins, and supplements also require prescription from your doctor to be eligible for reimbursement.)</p> <p>Some examples include:</p> <p>Antacids, Cold/cough medicine, Diarrhea medicines,</p>

First aid ointments,
Pain relievers,
Sleeping aid medication,
Sinus medications, ect

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Psychiatric Care	X			Expenses paid for psychiatric care are eligible for reimbursement. This can also include expenses used to support a mentally ill dependant at a specially equipped center where the dependant receives medical care. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed form other sources.
Psychoanalysis	X			Expenses paid for psychoanalysis are eligible for reimbursement. (Please note that expenses paid for psychoanalysis that is a required part for training to be a psychoanalyst are not eligible for reimbursement.)
Psychologist	X			Expenses paid to psychologists for medical care are eligible for reimbursement
Parking	X			Expenses paid for parking while receiving medical services are eligible for reimbursement
Pain relievers	X			Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter pain relievers are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor. Some examples include: Advil, Asprin, Bayer, Generics, Tylenol, ect.

Pregnancy test kit	X			
Prescription drugs	X			Expenses paid for prescription drugs purchased legally from the United States are eligible for reimbursement. Imported prescription drugs are not eligible for reimbursement. Prescription drugs purchased while traveling abroad for use while abroad are eligible for reimbursement as long as the prescription drug is legal both in the country you are traveling and the United States.

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Radial keratotomy	X			Medical expenses paid for vision correction surgeries such as radial keratotomy are eligible for reimbursement.
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S

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Sleeping aid medication	X			Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter sleep aid medication are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor. Some examples include: Advil PM, Generics, Tylenol Pm, Unisom, ect.
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Sterilization	X	Expenses paid for legal sterilization are eligible for reimbursement.
Smoking cessation	X	Expenses paid for over the counter smoking cessation are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.
Sinus medications		Expenses paid for prescription and over the counter sinus medications are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor. Some examples include: Afrin, Benadryl, Dayquil, Generics, Sudafed, Zicam, ect

T

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Toothbrush			X	Expenses paid for toothbrushes, electric and manual, are not eligible for reimbursement.
Transportation	X			Expenses paid for transportation that is primarily for and essential to medical care are eligible for reimbursement. Eligible expenses include: Bus, taxi, and train fares as well as ambulance service fees. Transportation expenses of a parent who must go with a child who need medical care.

Transportation expenses of a nurse or other person who can give injections, medications, or provide other treatments required by a patient who is traveling to receive medical care and cannot travel alone.

When recommended as part of treatment, the transportation expenses for regular visits to see a mentally ill dependent are eligible for reimbursement.

Telephone	X			Expenses paid for special telephone equipment that lets a hearing impaired person communicate over regular telephone are eligible for reimbursement. This includes expenses for teletypewriters (TTY) and telecommunication devices for the deaf (TDD) equipment. Expenses for repairing eligible equipment are also a reimbursable expense.

Throat lozenges	X			Expenses paid for over the counter throat lozenges are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor.

U

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Vasectomy	X			Expenses paid for a vasectomy are eligible for reimbursement.
Vision Correction Surgery	X			Expenses paid for vision correction surgeries are eligible for reimbursement. This includes LASIK and

radial keratotomy.

W

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Wheelchair				Expenses paid for autoettes or wheel chairs used mainly for the relief of sickness or disability and not to just provide transportation to and from work are eligible for reimbursement. Expenses of operating and maintaining autoettes or wheelchairs are also an eligible expense.
Wart remover				Medical expenses paid for prescription and over the counter wart removers are eligible for reimbursement with a prescription from your doctor. Some examples include Compound W, Dr. Scholl's, Genetics, Wart-Off, ect

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X-rays	X			Expenses paid for x-rays that are needed for medical reasons are eligible for reimbursement. Amounts claimed for reimbursement must not be reimbursed from other sources.
