Federal Loans:

Eligibility:

- US Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Enrolled in a Master's degree program
- Registered at least "half-time" (6 credits/semester or 2 courses)

Types:

- <u>Direct Unsubsidized Loan</u> (formerly Stafford) up to <u>\$20,500 / year</u>
- Graduate PLUS Loan

What to submit:

- FAFSA (FAFSA.ed.gov)
- Entrance Counseling & Master Promissory Note (<u>studentaid.gov</u>)
- BU Loan Request Form
