



BU Sargent College Alumni Awards

The Sargent College Alumni Award Ceremony is rich with history and tradition. The following is an explanation of the nomination procedure and expectations from the Awards Committee to ensure a successful selection of awardees.

The Awards

Dudley Allen Sargent Service Award

This is awarded to Sargent College alumni for meritorious service to the Sargent College Alumni Association.

Special Recognition Award

This is awarded to recognize unusual services or contributions of an alumnus. It is given to an individual who has made outstanding contributions to humanity beyond their professional responsibilities.

Twiness Award

This is awarded to those alumni who have proven themselves worthy of this honor, both from the standpoints of behavior and professionalism. Through the medium of these two attributes, they stand for the ideal spirit of Sargent College. It shall be awarded to those who are worthy to represent that spirit and who are workers, ready to serve for the advancement of the school. Please note that this award is for alumni accomplishments, not for past leadership while a student.

Black and Gold Award

This is awarded to any member of the Sargent College Alumni Association who has received the Dudley Allen Sargent Service Award, Special Recognition Award, and Twiness Award; and who is deemed worthy of continued recognition for ongoing contributions to Sargent College and/or the SCAA.

Professional Achievement Award

This award is given to an alumnus who has translated his or her Sargent experience into practice, resulting in the advancement of health and rehabilitation sciences.

Nomination Procedure

Please type your nomination and include the following details:

1. Name, address, phone number, and class year of the person whom you are nominating.
2. Name of the award for which you are nominating this person.
3. Justification for the award: information related to nominee's professional contributions to BU Sargent College. This may be in the form of a résumé, CV, narrative, or copies of articles from newspapers and/or magazines. It is very important to use specific details to support your nominations. Please include length of service at jobs and volunteer commitments, and information about other awards or recognition this person has received. A nomination can not be purely editorial comments. It is preferable that each nomination be accompanied by

multiple letters of recommendation. **Nomination packets that do not include the required information will not be considered.**
