In Asia, you dialog with top executives and grapple with current problems faced by multinational companies or build a robust business plan for success in the Asia-Pacific context. Upon arriving in Boston, you will participate in consulting projects and challenges in both campus and company-led initiatives like the P&G Gillette Sustainability Challenge, Grand Business Challenge in Digital Health, and Collaborative Consulting. Throughout your education, your strategies will be challenged by classmates from many different countries with diverse industry experience.
