In turn, such an understanding further calls for a process of learning an array of key notions and conceptual tools that will be methodically introduced and explicated throughout the semester.</p>

<p>This class consists of 10 lectures, addresses various aspects of Chinese society. Specifically, we choose some particular topics that relate to Confucian teachings, <i>guanxi</i> practices in Chinese's daily life, native religions and belief, historical transition since the Mao's era, population polices, the development of internet, and the feminist movement. These topics concern the most significant ones in the general sociology of China, thus serving to familiarize students, both domestic and international ones, with the present cultural, political, economic, and societal states of China.</p>
