



Glossary:

rana: sun, (here) usefulness, importance

halitta: creature

Allah ya ba ka nasara: Good luck!

ɓarna: (of animals) eating of someone's plants on their farm

baga (pl. **baga-baga**): pile of millet or corn ears left on the farm to dry before bringing home

bisashe (sg. **bias**): animals

tabka: to commit (a serious offence)

makiyaya (sg. **makiyayi**): Shepherd, herder

burtali: big path made for herd of animals to pass to avoid destruction of corn farms

gona: corn or millet farm

tabbata: to ensure, be sure

yi imani (da): to agree with

kwato: to grab, to obtain by force or out of pressure

lelleka: to visit (farm) from time to time

hasara: a loss
