Students must earn a **minimum** of 32 course units with grades no lower than B- in graduate-level coursework per the <u>Bulletin</u> (see <u>Bulletin archives</u> for pre-Fall 2024 curriculum). Refer to the <u>Graduate Student Handbook</u> for the full complement of policies and procedures, including the following general notes:

- If MT 401 (2 units) theory review is required per the <u>proficiency entrance exam</u>, it does not count towards the degree and must be passed with at least a B- before a student can take graduate theory (MT 601 or 602)
- Use of elective units:
 - o Students can choose from grad courses (500 level and above) with SoM prefixes MU, ME, MP, MH, MT
 - o MET graduate classes in Arts Administration will satisfy elective units
 - Applied lessons may be taken up to 4 units per semester. Any additional lesson units(s) beyond the required 12 will satisfy elective units, but no more than 2 units of extra lessons may be applied towards electives. Students must submit a <u>course substitution form</u> to request use of additional lesson units for elective units
- Students must register for 7 units minimum to a maximum of 11.5 units per semester for full-time status
- Students are expected to register for classes on <u>published dates</u> and must register for classes each semester through graduation unless taking an approved <u>leave of absence</u>
- All students MUST <u>apply to graduate</u> before their final semester of study, complete all degree program requirements, and earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 to be awarded a degree per <u>CFA</u> <u>Graduation Policy</u>.
