Each student, in consultation with his or her research advisor, will select the members of a Dissertation Advisory Committee (DAC) and submit the list of names to the chair of the Graduate Program Committee for approval. This committee will consist of three to five faculty members including the research advisor, and may include faculty from outside the department or from other institutions. At least three members of the committee should be from the Boston University Chemistry Department. With approval of the major advisor and the GAC, the members of the DAC may be changed during a student's graduate career to assure effective committee composition.
