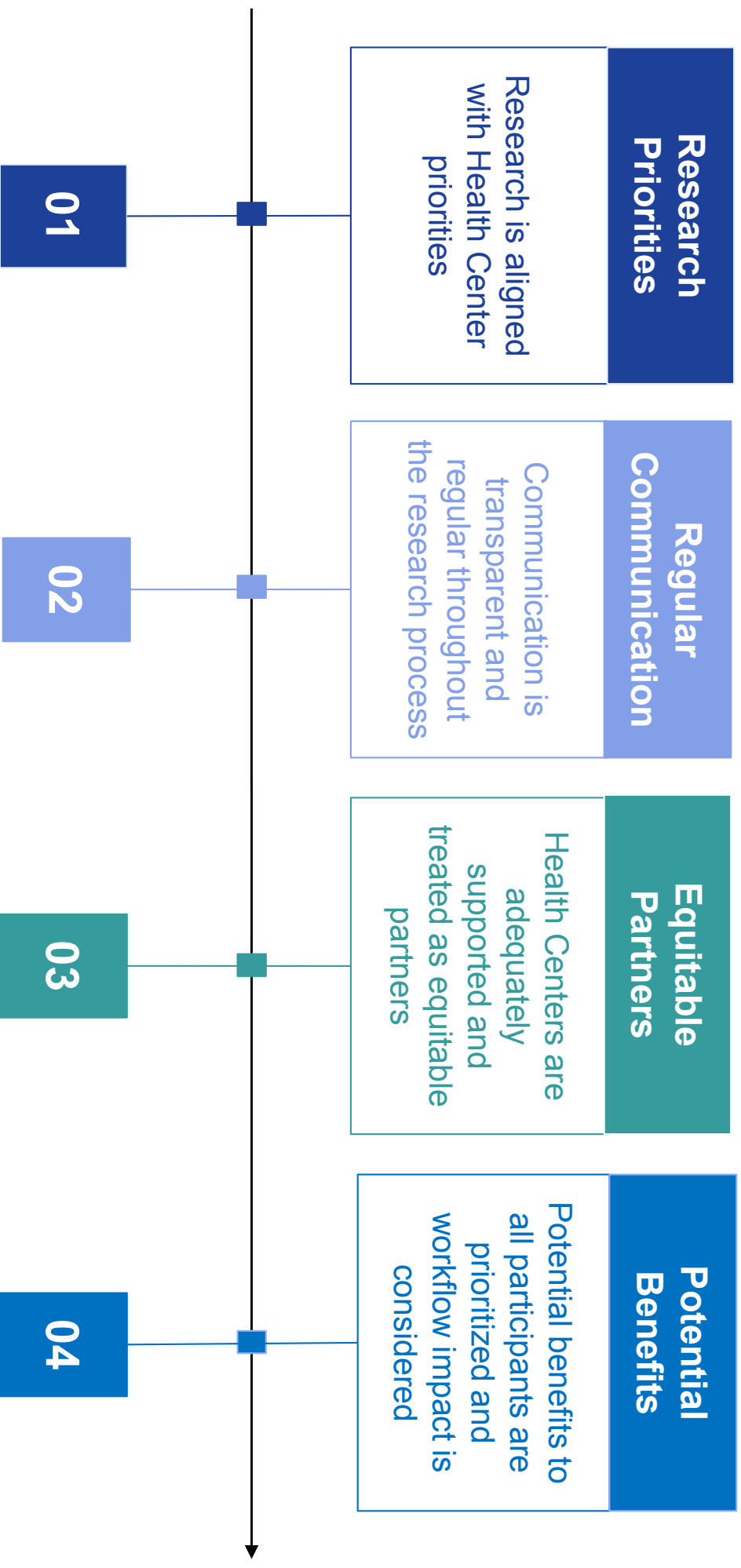

Guiding Principles and Rules of Engagement

I Research is aligned with Health Center priorities

<p>Researcher Role</p>	<p>To be aware of Health Center priorities identified in the CHC bios below</p> <p>Address local relevance of the research</p>	<p>Health Center Role</p>	<p>Review and update CHC bios annually</p>
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II Communication is transparent and regular throughout the research process

<p>Researcher Role</p>	<p>Invite Health Centers to discuss ideas at least 1 month before a research grant submission</p> <p>Discuss budget guidelines and award amount</p> <p>Develop data use and security plan</p> <p>Define a cadence and method for reporting study progress to the Health Center</p>	<p>Health Center Role</p>	<p>Review requests for research when approached 1 month in advance of a grant submission</p> <p>Provide written response on research participation within 2 weeks of receiving requests</p> <p>Allows prep to research quires by CDW analysts for counts that align with priorities</p>
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Guiding Principles and Rules of Engagement

III Health Centers are adequately supported and treated as equitable partners

Researcher Role	Health Center Role
Engage health centers in ongoing dialogue about space, time, and other supports required to participate in the project	Clearly articulate resources needed to partner and participate in the project
Share resources to support health center participation in the project including leadership and recognition	Consider participating in joint authorship of the project manuscript(s)

IV Potential benefits to all participants are prioritized and workflow impact is considered

Researcher Role	Health Center Role
Consider study methodology where control groups receive some benefit other than compensation, if possible	Review and update best practices annually
Allow patients to opt in to be contacted rather than opt out, if possible	
Consider the feasibility of integrating the study methodology into health center specific workflows and best practices
