Relational Spirituality and Intercultural Competence: Barriers and Pathways to Mature Alterity



Humans invoke the sacred to support a variety of ways of relating to outgroup members or experiences of otherness, ranging from xenophobia to compassion. This presentation briefly reviews findings from a series of empirical studies on spiritual and psychological predictors of intercultural competence based on a differentiation-based model of relational spirituality. Dialogue will be invited about next steps in research on spiritual or religious dynamics that can promote effective relations across socio-cultural differences.
