

What is a Career Fair and Why Should I Go?

WHAT IS A CAREER FAIR?

A career fair is a recruiting event in which recruiters and hiring managers meet with potential employees. Career Fairs come in different formats:

- **Virtual:** Hosted on online platforms, each with their own procedures
- **In-person:** Organized in large spaces where employers set up booths or tables
- **Hybrid:** Virtual and in-person fairs hosted back-to-back

Why do employers go to a career fair?

- Recruit and screen job-seekers for currently open positions.
- Raise brand awareness about job or internship opportunities, culture, and benefits.
- Build talent pipelines and prepare students to apply to their company in the future.

WHY SHOULD I GO?

LEARN

- Discover roles and employers you haven't heard of before
- Explore employers for your job/internship search process
- Find out what specific employers look for in candidates
- Hear about upcoming job or internships opportunities
- Receive feedback about your resume and experience

PRACTICE

- Polish talking about yourself professionally
- Ask questions about the company you wish to apply to
- Get to know recruiters and engineers

APPLY

- Make your interest known to a person on the inside
- Get insider tips on how to apply and stand out
- Network with representatives and build relationships
