## List of fines and sanctions Updated Fall 2021

**The fines listed are consistent with those applied on Boston University's Charles River Campus.**

**CHF 10 fines must be paid in cash at the office. All other fines will be assessed on your Boston University student account.**

<b>Fine</b>	<b>Amount</b>
Leaving communal areas in a dirty or messy state	CHF 10 per student
Non-respect of the recycling policy	\$ 260 per floor or \$ 60 per bedroom
Leaving your bedroom or bathroom in a dirty or messy state after departure.	\$ 120 per room
Eating or drinking in the study room or in the classroom	CHF 10
Losing your key	\$ 100
Locking yourself out and having to call staff between 10:00 pm and 7:00am, or during the weekend.	CHF 10
Damage to property or equipment	Full cost of repair or replacement
Smoking or vaporizing in the residence	\$ 50
Rowdy, noisy, uncouth or drunken behavior. Disrespectful or impolite behavior to staff or students	\$ 50
Having a visitor overnight Giving your key to someone else	\$ 150 – and withdrawal of visitor privileges
Police calls or complaints from neighbors due to noise	\$ 50
Tampering with fire safety equipment. Endangering the health and safety of others.	Students can be separated from the residence and fined up to \$2000. In addition, students can be suspended from the University for a semester, or a year
Serious incidents or repeat offenses	Will be referred to the Office of Judicial Affairs, in addition to the application of a fine
