The SPH Center for Global Health and Development's **Graduate Research Affiliate Program (GRAP)** provides opportunities for masters and doctoral students to be collaborators and research assistants on faculty research. GRAP provides students with the opportunity to gain hands on research experience through short- and longer-term research projects and to build relationships with SPH faculty conducting global health research.

Graduate research opportunities prepared by faculty will be announced and an application made available by close of business (cob) November 4th, 2016.

Applications are due November 15th, 2015.

Students will apply with a CV/resume and will be asked to briefly explain why they are interested in that opportunity, and any relevant skills/experiences. Students are encouraged to apply for up to three (3) opportunities. The GRAP coordinators will match students and faculty and send out letters of introduction in early December.
