<b>Housing</b>	Students typically live in on-campus dormitories, but housing is not guaranteed and students may have to find housing off-campus depending on availability.
<b>Living Costs</b>	Fees for the fall semester are roughly estimated as follows: Housing: \$2,000 (based on 5 month stay – 12,250 CNY or approximately \$400 per month). Meals: \$1,200 (Tsinghua estimates approximately 7250 yuan for your entire stay) Books and Supplies: \$215 Public Transportation: \$130 Registration Fee: \$30 (180 CNY) Insurance Fee: \$50 (300 CNY) Visa Fee: \$115 (700 CNY) Miscellaneous: \$200 Total estimated living expenses for a single semester at Tsinghua: \$3,940.
<b>Typical Course Load</b>	Course loads and options are determined by the LLM in Chinese Law Program curriculum. Students are expected to pursue the equivalent of 12 BU Law credit hours.

<b>Special Considerations</b>	Chinese citizens are not eligible to participate per Tsinghua policy. Admitted students need to submit additional materials to Tsinghua that will be used to process visa-related paperwork.
