The National Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Workforce Development Center will accept student applications for the Title V MCH Internship Program from **January 6th through February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. ## Why should you apply to the Title V MCH Internship Program?

As a Title V MCH Intern, you will:

- Work on a project focused on improving the health of women, children, and families
- Have an opportunity to mentor or be mentored as part of a two-person team of MCH students
- Learn about the MCH health system of your assigned state
- Network with leaders in the field of MCH and students from other MCH Training Programs
- Receive training in MCH systems, leadership, building collaborative relationships, team-building, and mentoring

## Eligibility:

- Must be a student in one of the following MCH Training Programs:

  - ◊ [Maternal and Child Health Public Health Catalyst Program](#)
- Must be a student who will enroll in the Fall 2020 semester or is participating in the program as an academic requirement
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

## Program Dates

The program will be held from **June 8 to July 31, 2020**. Students are expected to work full-time and to be on-site during the program. Note that students who are on the quarter system may start on June 15, 2020 and would conclude the program on August 7th, 2020.

## Stipend

Student interns receive a **\$4500** stipend to cover the cost of living and transportation.

## Timeline

- State applications are due in November 2019.
- **The student application period is January 6—February 7, 2020.**
- State and student teams will be matched in late February and informed of decisions in March 2020.

## Housing

Student interns are expected to secure their own housing and transportation.
