The National Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Workforce Development Center will accept student applications for the Title V MCH Internship Program from <u>January 6th through February 7th, 2020</u>. Why should you apply to the Title V MCH Internship Program? As a Title V MCH Intern, you will:

- Work on a project focused on improving the health of women, children, and families
- Have an opportunity to mentor or be mentored as part of a twoperson team of MCH students
- Learn about the MCH health system of your assigned state
- Network with leaders in the field of MCH and students from other MCH Training Programs
- Receive training in MCH systems, leadership, building collaborative relationships, team-building, and mentoring

Eligibility:

- Must be a student in one of the following MCH Training Programs:
 - ♦ Centers of Excellence in Maternal and Child Health
 - ♦ Maternal and Child Health Pipeline Program
 - Maternal and Child Health Public Health Catalyst Program
- Must be a student who will enroll in the Fall 2020 semester or is participating in the program as an academic requirement
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Program Dates

The program will be held from June 8 to July 31, 2020. Students are expected to work full-time and to be on-site during the program. Note that students who are on the quarter system may start on June 15, 2020 and would conclude the program on August 7th, 2020.

Stipend

Student interns receive a <u>\$4500</u> stipend to cover the cost of living and transportation.

Timeline

- State applications are due in November 2019.
- The student application period is January 6— February 7, 2020.
- State and student teams will be matched in late February and informed of decisions in March 2020.

Housing

Student interns are expected to secure their own housing and transportation.
