

MCH Fellowship and Diversity Scholars Leadership Program Frequently Asked Questions (version 19 Sep. 2023)

General Questions

1. Can I apply for both the Diversity Scholars Program (DSLP) and also the MCH Fellowship?

Yes, you can apply to both the programs separately using their respective applications. These applications will be reviewed separately. Receiving an offer from one does not disqualify you from also receiving an offer from the other. Although uncommon, we have had strong applicants awarded the MCH Fellowship and DSLP during the same cycle.

2. What is the difference between the practice and research fellowship?

The *practice fellowship* entails working with an organization in the Boston area and can also be used to fulfil the practicum requirement.

The *research fellowship* entails working with BUSPH faculty on a research project and may not always be used to fulfil the practicum requirement (see additional details on next question). However, BUSPH faculty may be flexible over the summertime with the fellowship hours (8-10 hours a week) so that students can do their practicum elsewhere.

3. I am interested in more than one fellowship project. How many fellowship projects can I apply to?

You can choose to rank 3 of your top fellowship project options (1 being your top choice) on the fellowship application. You can rank between the research and practice fellowship project options using the same application. It is recommended to customize your application responses as best as possible to reflect your interest in the projects you rank. You can also highlight your qualifications on your resume/CV.

4. What are the requirements for the MCH Fellowship application?

5. I cannot start my fellowship in December, is there flexibility on start dates?

Fellowships typically start in December of every year; however, this can be negotiated to begin January of the following year if the project supervisor is flexible with a January start date.

6. Does the MCH Fellowship offer tuition support?

No, the fellowship does not provide tuition support. Instead, it provides a stipend of \$1,500 that is paid over 3 installments of \$500 over the fellowship year. Tuition support of 6 credits is provided by the DSLP program and can be applied to separately from the MCH fellowships based on eligibility.

7. Can I apply to both DSLP program options (URM and LGBTQIA+)?

Yes, if you <u>qualify</u> for both the DSLP-URM (underrepresented minority) and DSLP-LGBTQIA requirements, you can note that you want to be considered for both on the <u>DSLP application</u>. One application is used to apply to both opportunities. A resume/CV is also required.



MCH Fellowship and Practicum Questions

8. Which fellowships can also be used to fulfil my practicum?

Practice fellowships are automatically eligible to count towards the MPH practicum as it interfaces with a practice-based organization.

Research fellowships are often eligible to count towards the MPH practicum requirements depending on the type of work and stakeholders' fellow's will interface with during their fellowship year. Eligibility will be determined by the BUSPH Practicum Office. Please check the <u>research fellowship page</u> to verify which projects will qualify per application cycle.

 - a. Good standing
 - b. Passing core courses
- 10. I have verified that my fellowship project is practicum eligible, and I want it to count towards my MPH practicum, what are the next steps?

There is a separate BUSPH practicum registration process that fellows must use to register their practicum.

11. When do my fellowship hours start counting towards my practicum?

Hours begin counting once you have submitted a practicum proposal in the online portal, and it has gone through the three-step review process. Your start date in the portal should be the beginning of the Spring semester (or the semester in which you would become eligible for). 12. I am a part time student and I have not finished my core courses yet. Can I still have my fellowship hours count towards my practicum?
