PROGRAM SUMMARY

The Honors Program in Political Science challenges you to explore politics in three ways: first, by taking and excelling in advanced coursework; second, by engaging in original research to produce a thesis; and third, by experiencing the practical world of politics and government. It is the most stimulating intellectual enterprise in which an undergraduate can engage, demanding dedication, creativity, and the ability to exercise independent judgment.

CURRICULUM

Students who wish to graduate with Honors must satisfactorily complete a research methods course with a minimum grade of B, conduct two semester of Directed Study with a minimum grade of B+, and successfully complete the writing and defense of a thesis and presentation of the research.

Students will enroll in these courses which will count towards their BA requirements:

Thesis Requirements:

- The thesis must be distinct from previous undergraduate coursework
- Students may not resubmit work done during undergraduate coursework as their thesis, but they may build off of topics explored in previous courses
- Students will present and defend their thesis at the end of the year to a committee of three faculty members
