## Sociology Minor Requirements

The minor in sociology is designed for students from other disciplines who are interested in the theoretical ideas and research methods used by sociologists in their study of society. Students have the opportunity to take a wide range of courses that provide a valuable perspective for understanding the social issues at work and in daily life.

The minor in sociology is comprised of 6 sociology courses, as described below. All courses for the minor must be completed with grades of C or higher.

Minors in sociology are required to take 6 courses in sociology. Courses are required as follows:

BU CAS SO 201 Soc Methods (2nd year class, prereq Intro)	
BU CAS SO 203 Soc Theories (2nd year class, prereq Intro)	
Two additional CAS SO courses 200+ (anytime)	
Two additional CAS SO courses 300+	

- SO 100 can substitute for one 200+ level CAS SO course.
- SO 201 and SO 203 must be taken in the BU Sociology Department. No transfers will be accepted.
- Only one Metropolitan College course can be counted towards the Sociology Minor, at no higher than the 200 level, and only with approval by the Director of Undergraduate Studies.
- CGS Students who have completed CGS SS 101 & SS 102 *or* CGS SS 103 & SS 104, each with a grade of C or higher will receive SO 100 credit.
- Core Curriculum students who have completed CC221 may receive SO 100 level credit.
